

SHORT FILM CONTEST

EuroGlobe “101 Seconds Film Award” (Belgium)

The EuroGlobe Short Film Contest asks Belgian film makers to submit creative and innovative short cuts dealing with the themes global warming and climate change as well as its consequences for Europe and in particular Belgium.

The overall topic of the contest is: “Act now!”. All kinds of short films are permitted, whether documentaries, music clips, fictional short cuts, or other. The maximum duration of each film is 101 seconds.

Who can participate

Professional and non-professional film makers of all ages.

Deadline for submission

Extended to 15th of June 2010.

Jury

A selected jury with a background in film will choose the best contributions. The names of the jury members will be published soon.

Selection Procedure

The jury selects the best short cuts to be shown publicly at the festival in Namur and in Antwerp in 2010. The screenings will be running during the festivals in Namur and Antwerp as official part of the EuroGlobe festival program.

Voting

Audience Voting - The visitors of the festivals in Namur and Antwerp will select the best short cut by secret audience voting.

Online Voting - The visitors of the EuroGlobe website can participate with a secret online voting and choose the best short cut.

The film with most audience and online votes combined wins the competition.

Winning Prize

The winner is awarded a high-quality digital camera. In addition, the best short cut will be shown in the framework of the next Jeugdfilmfestival in Antwerp (Belgium).
